Technology

We have class sets TI 84 calculators; having one at home would also be beneficial. We will use other technology as well. When appropriate, have it ready to go. When not, make sure it is off and put away. **IMPORTANT:** Students caught having a cell phone on their person or using personal technology during tests or quizzes will be assumed to be cheating and referred to their assistant principal. Students found to be cheating on an assessment will receive a zero for that grade.

How to be successful in PAP Geometry

Come ready to learn and do your best each day. This means bringing your notes, pencil, appropriate technology, and homework with you each and every day. Math will be a challenge from time to time, so don't give up! Perseverance is everything; I will never give up trying to teach you.

Things You will need

3. Supplies to turn in - 1 package of pencils and 1 box of tissues

Grading Policies

- Tests will count for 75% of your 9 week average, quizzes for 15%, homework, warm ups, or any other daily assignments for 10%.
- You may have the opportunity to retake a major test upon completion of corrections to the original test here at school. Re-tests may be different from the original test, but will assess the same material. The maximum score on a retest is 70%.
- Graded work must be done in pencil.
- Process skills will also be scored. In most cases students will be expected to show their steps using the requested process. Watch for specific instructions on rounding and units as these can also be scored.

A student has one day for each day missed to turn in an assignment for excused absences. Assignment lists and calendars are handed out and made available online to help you find out what you missed. It will be up to you to turn it in. Homework that is one day late will receive a maximum score of 70. Reviews and take-home quizzes will **not** be accepted late. If a test is missed you will need to take it on a make-up testing day, or arrange an alternative time with me. Missed test or makeups must take place within 1 week of test day.


